As provided under Federal regulations at 42 CFR § 1007.20(a), the Office of Inspector General (OIG) approves the application of the New York Medicaid Fraud Control Unit's request for renewal of its data mining approval.

Under the regulations, the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit may request renewal of this approval for additional 3-year periods by submitting a written request to OIG. Please ensure that you continue to include the outcomes of your data mining activities as part of the Unit's recertification materials that are due by March 1, 2023, as outlined in section 1007.17(a)(1)(ii) of the regulations.
